

The 15th Annual Research Session (ARS) 2025

Author Guidelines

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Abstracts should report original research.
- Documents that do not follow the guidelines will be rejected.
- Documents received after the given deadline, for any reason, will not be accepted unless the deadline is extended.
- The word limit should not exceed 300 words.

FORMAT FOR ABSTRACTS:

- Paper size and Orientation: B5 portrait
- All margins except left: 1". Left margin: 1.25". Gutter: 00
- Font: Times New Roman, 11 points; Line spacing: 1, one column of text.
- No Header or Footer except 15 mm Footer for page numbering
- All the details should be arranged on one page (strictly follow the formatting guidelines)
- Title
 - Font type and size: Times New Roman, 14
 - Centered text in bold
 - Title Case
 - Abstract titles should be short but descriptive. Informative titles, indicating key points, are encouraged. Abbreviations should not be used in the title. Scientific names must be in italics.
- Affiliations
 - Font type and size: Times New Roman 11
 - Names should be indicated with superscript Arabic numbers appearing at the end of surname/family name.
 - A superscript asterisk should be used for the corresponding author
 - Names of affiliations should be given, including the country
 - If there is more than one name and address, they should be related by superscript numbers
 - The corresponding author's email address should be included
- Abstract

The abstract should contain an introduction to the study with the objectives, methodology, and results, followed by a short discussion and a conclusion(s) presented in a single paragraph without

subheadings or references. Use only the SI units. Keep a single space between two types of units (e.g. J mol⁻¹ K⁻¹). Use negative exponent (e.g. kg m⁻³) and do not indicate units as divisions (e.g. kg/m³). Chemical formulae should be written in a standard form such as “CaCO₃”, not as “CaCO3”. Use a zero before decimal points, such as “0.45,” not “.45.” Keywords should be given, leaving one-line space below the text.

Keywords: Keyword 1, keyword 2, keyword 3, keyword 4, keyword 5 (should be arranged in alphabetical order)
